

IQAC ANNUAL REPORT-2024-25

I am pleased to present the Annual Report of the College in respect of Academic, Curricular, Extracurricular and Co-curricular activities during the academic year 2024-25. The IQAC has taken up several quality initiatives during 2024-25 as a part of its efforts to sustain and enhance the academic quality activities of the college.

The Departments of Life Sciences both UG and PG observed 'World Environmental Day' on 05-06-2024 in a way to create awareness among the staff and students and to encourage action to protect the environment. To mark the occasion of celebrating nature, a good number of saplings were planted in the college campus to promote the environment into a greener and healthier space. The college organized Medical and Dental Camp on 16-06-2024 in association with Amrutha Hospital and Ratna's Multispecialty Dental Hospitals Penugonda facilitating the staff and students free health check-ups and to create awareness on preventive health care and early detection of health issues.

The programme served for nearly 73 patients to make use of the services. The International Yoga Day was celebrated in the college on 21-06-2024 with the amicable support of Dr. Ch. Sulakshanamani, Medical Officer Department of AYUSH, CHNC Penugonda focusing on the benefits of yoga. The programme was initiated by the Principal of the college with the participation of a large number of student and staff. The programme highlighted the mental well-being of the participants to maintain healthy life style and emotional balance.

A Dental Camp was organized on 01-07-2024 in Association with Vishnu Dental College Bhimavaram in which nearly 113 participants with dental issues got benefitted. The College organized Vanamahostav Programme from 01-07-2024 to 07-07-2024. On this Occasion 25 Saplings were Planted in the campus and 67 students actively participated in the programme. On the occasion of World Population Day, the College conducted Essay Writing and Elocution Competitions on 11-07-2024 in which 70 students participated. The college celebrated 'National Handlooms Day' on 07-08-2024 to honour the legacy of India's handloom industry. On this Occasion Essay writing Competition on "The Importance of Handlooms during Quit India Movement" was conducted. An awareness meeting also was conducted on Handlooms and discussed its importance in Freedom movement in which around 67 students participated. A rally on 'Anti Drug Awareness and Tobacco free Youth campaign 2.0 Awareness Programme was organized with 43 youth on 08-08-2024. The Department in collaboration with Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajamahendravaram organized a Two-day International Telugu Conference on "Vasavi Vamgamaya Bharathi" on 27th and 28th Novemebr, 2024.

As per the directions of Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and Adikavi Nannaya University, the college NSS Units conducted a plantation programme on the occasion of Green Campus-Clean Campus on 05-09-2024. The occasion raised an inspiration for planting 112 saplings in the college campus. Nearly 39 Students and some staff members participated in the programme. The college celebrated 'Teachers' Day' on 5th September, 2024 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. Sarvepalli Radha Krishnan. On this occasion the teaching faculty whose articles published in various reputed journals was felicitated by the college Management. The college celebrated 'Independence Day' on 15th August 2024 and inculcated the spirit of sacrifice among the students.

The Department of Botany (UG) organized an Awareness Programme on 'Ozone Depletion' on 16-09-2024 and made the students aware of the danger of ozone layer depletion. The NSS Units organized a one day Special Plantation Drive on 17-09-2024 on the Occasion of 'EK PED MAA KE NAAM Campaign' for Sustainable Environment in which 25 saplings were planted in the college campus and 30 students participated. On the eve of NSS day Celebrations, Elocution and Essay Writing competitions were conducted on 24-09-2024 and 42 Students actively participated. The College organised a Blood Donation Camp on 30-09-2024 in association with Apadbandu Blood Bank Palakollu and 53 Students donated their blood. The students and staff actively and voluntarily donated blood. It raised an awareness among the students that donation of blood can reduce the risk of heart attack. The College hosted for Voter Awareness Programme by L. Kiran Kumar, Mandal Revenue Inspector, A.O. Durga Prasad Penugond, on 30-09-2024.

The College Conducted a talk on "Personality Development" on 02-10-2024 for which the Principal Dr.Y.V.V.Apparao was invited as chief guest. The college organized Blood Grouping Identification Programme for 1st year students on 03-10-2024 and nearly 129 students participated and were tested their blood groups in a way to know their body type which is very crucial for safe blood transfusion in emergency situations. The college organized an Awareness Programme on 'Personality Development & Career Guidance' by inviting eminent resource persons in various fields like K. Prabhakar CEO SET WELL Eluru, S.Pattabhi Ramanna Manager AP Tourism, K.Rama Krishna National Yoga Coach, G.Praveen Krishna Young Professional National Career Services & Dr. K.Pallavi Associate Professor of law, Andhra University, Visakhapatnam.

The College organized a '3 Month Online Campus Technical Career Training Programme' from 17-10-2024 to 13-03-2025 by inviting TNF-IF (CSR Initiative of Capgemini) for MCA students who passed in 2025 batch. The college celebrated National Integration Day (National Unity Day) on the eve of Sardhar Vallabai Jayanthi on 26-10-2024. On this Occasion Elocution & Run for India competitions were conducted and Principal Dr.Y.V.V.Appa Rao was invited as Chief Guest. Around 54 students participated in the programme. The college celebrated 'National Education Day' on 11-11-2024. On this occasion, Essay Writing Competition on "Modern Education Policy" was conducted. In this programme Principal Dr. Y.V.V.Appa Rao addressed the students.

The College Organized Anti Ragging Meeting for 2nd and final year students on 11-11-2024 in association with IQAC highlighting the ill effects of ragging. Sri K.Gangadhar SI of Police Penugonda was invited as Chief Guest and Principal Dr. YVV Appa Rao was invited as guest of honour. The college celebrated 'National Constitution Day' which also known as Samvidhan Divas on 26-11-2024 to commemorate the adoption of the Indian Constitution. On this occasion a meeting was conducted on 'Indian constitution' for which Principal Dr YVV Apparao was invited as chief guest. Nearly 51 students participated in the meeting which reflected the principles of Indian democracy i.e. Liberty, Equality and Fraternity. The death anniversary of Dr BR Ambedkar's was organized in the college on 06-12-2024 and remembered his endless efforts to uplift the downtrodden. The NSS Volunteers of the college extended their services to Subrahmanyam Swami Temple at Itempudi on 07-12-2024 on the occasion of Subrahmanyam Swami Sasti Festival. The College encouraged and directed UG and MCA students to attend Infosys Campus drive held at Aditya University, Kakinada, sponsored by APITA, Govt. of A.P., on 24-12-2024 and 2 Students were selected i.e. one UG student (V.Lakshman) and one MCA student (V.Vedavani).

The College organized 'National Youth Day Celebrations' on the occasion of Swami Vivekananda Jayanthi from 09-01-2025 to 10-01-2025. Academic competitions like Volleyball, Kabaddi, Chess, Skipping, and Rangoli were conducted and nearly 210 students participated in various programmes. The Department of Telugu organized Bala Vyakaranavadhaanam by Kum. Mukke Harika on 21-01-2025. The extraordinary memory power of Harika at an early age made the audience spellbound. The college celebrated 'National Voters Day' on 25-01-2025. On this occasion Elocution & Essay Writing Competitions were conducted and 54 students participated. The college conducted a meeting on the eve of Mahatma Gandhi Varthanthi on 30-01-2025. The chief guest and Principal Dr. Y.V.V. Apparao distributed certificates to the NSS volunteers. The college conducted 'Republic Day Celebrations' on 26-01-2025. On this occasion a quiz programme on 'Culture, Heritage & Traditions Of India's 75 years of Indian Constitution', an Essay Writing on "The Invincible Journey of Indian Republic Past & Future", and Painting Competition on Rachnaatmak Bharath were conducted. The students extended their services to Akhila Bharatha Sri Vasavi Santhi Dham Temple on 30-01-2025 & 31-01-2025. The college encouraged all B. Sc students to attend TCS iGnite Test on 14-02-2025 in which 4 UG students were selected for final round of interview. i.e. (1.V.Lakshman, MCCs, 2.V.Ramarao, MCCs, 3.T Umamaheswari, MPCs and 4. K. Satish, MECs.)

As per the Guidelines of Govt. of A, P. the college observed 3rd Saturday of every month to conduct Swarna Andhra – Swachha Andhra Programme. As a part of the Programme a good number of students are involved in Plantation and Clean & Green programmes, collection of plastics & composting organic waste within the campus in the college on 15-02-2025. The College organized off campus interviews for chemistry students for Divi's Labs. Hyderabad on 24-02-2025 and 44 students are kept in waiting for results.

The college NSS volunteers actively participated in Maha Sivrathri Training Conducted by SP office Narasapur on 25-02-2025. The College organized off campus interviews for PG Science students for Chaitanya Institutions, Rajahmundry Zone on 01-03-2025 and 16 students are still in waiting for results. The college organized on-campus interviews for MCA students for Virtues, a Product Based Software Company, Hyderabad 10-03-2025 and 4 MCA students were selected.
