

IQAC ANNUAL REPORT (2025–2026)

It gives me immense pleasure to present the Annual Report of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) for the academic year 2025–2026, highlighting the significant academic, curricular, co-curricular, and extension activities undertaken by the college. Throughout the year, the IQAC initiated and coordinated several quality enhancement measures in line with the objectives of the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), with the aim of sustaining excellence in teaching, learning, research, extension, and institutional development.

The academic year commenced with the observance of World Environment Day on 5th June 2025, organized by the Departments of Life Sciences (UG & PG). The programme focused on creating environmental awareness among students and staff. As part of the celebration, a large number of saplings were planted across the campus, reinforcing the institution's commitment to environmental sustainability and ecological conservation. To enhance students' career prospects, the college organized a Pool Campus Recruitment Drive in collaboration with MSN Laboratories, Hyderabad, on 19th June 2025 for Chemistry students. Out of 93 participating students, 19 were successfully selected, reflecting the institution's continuous efforts towards strengthening industry-institution interaction and improving employability.

The college celebrated International Yoga Day on 21st June 2025 with great enthusiasm. Sri N. Ramachandra Reddy, Yoga Teacher, served as the resource person and explained the significance of yoga in promoting physical fitness, mental well-being, emotional stability, and a healthy lifestyle. The programme was inaugurated by the Principal, with active participation from students and faculty members.

The institution successfully implemented the Community Service Project (CSP) for first-year degree students from 11th May 2025 to 10th July 2025. The programme engaged students in meaningful community service activities, nurturing empathy, social responsibility, leadership qualities, and civic consciousness. An Anti-Ragging Awareness Programme was conducted on 18th July 2025, featuring Sri R. Vijay Kumar, Circle Inspector of Police, and Sri S. Gangadhar Rao, Sub-Inspector of Police, Penugonda, as resource persons. They sensitized students to the legal consequences of ragging and emphasized the importance of maintaining a safe and inclusive campus environment.

In compliance with the Government of Andhra Pradesh's initiative, the college regularly organized the Swarna Andhra – Swachha Andhra Programme on every third Saturday of the month. Various activities such as campus cleaning, plastic waste collection, plantation drives, hand-wash awareness campaigns, and zero-waste initiatives were conducted to promote environmental cleanliness and sustainability. A Seven-Day (40 Hours) Employability Skill Training Programme was organized from 28th July to 3rd August 2025 for 116 final-year girl students. Sponsored by the Naandi Foundation, the programme focused on developing communication skills, personality development, teamwork, problem-solving abilities, and workplace readiness.

The college organized a Blood Donation Camp on 20th August 2025 in association with the Government Community Health Centre, Penugonda. The programme was inaugurated by Principal Dr. Y. V. V. Appa Rao, along with Dr. Sonia Mohan and Dr. G. Chandreswari, Medical Officers. Students enthusiastically participated in the noble cause of voluntary blood donation. Another Blood Donation Camp was organized in association with ASRAM Medical College, Eluru, on 21st November 2025, during which 43 students voluntarily donated blood. Students also rendered voluntary services during the Subrahmanya Sashti Mahotsavam celebrations at Penugonda, Itempudi, and Nadipudi on 26 November 2025, reflecting the institution's commitment to community engagement. Another Blood Donation Camp was also organized on 31st January 2026 in association with Apadbandhu Blood Bank, Palakollu, to commemorate the Mahatma Gandhi Vardhanti.

The institution celebrated Independence Day on 15th August 2025 with patriotic fervour, inspiring students to uphold the values of freedom, national unity, and sacrifice. The Department of Telugu also organized the Birth Centenary Celebrations of Munipalli Raju on 30th August 2025, paying tribute to the eminent literary personality. Teachers' Day was celebrated on 5th September 2025 to commemorate the birth anniversary of Dr. Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan. Faculty members whose research articles were published in reputed journals during the year were felicitated by the college management in recognition of their academic achievements.

An awareness programme on Disaster Management was conducted on 4th September 2025 by the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) team. Students were trained on disaster preparedness, flood rescue techniques, fire safety, gas leakage management, and emergency response procedures. The college also organized a Women's Safety and Hygiene Awareness Programme on 18th September 2025, where Smt. K.Swarnalatha delivered an informative session emphasizing personal hygiene and the use of organic and eco-friendly sanitary products. On the occasion of NSS Day, celebrated on 24th September 2025, various competitions including Essay Writing, Elocution, and Quiz were organized to encourage students' intellectual and creative abilities. The institution celebrated Gandhi Jayanti on 2nd October 2025, conducting competitions on Gandhian philosophy and values. Winners were felicitated by Principal Dr. Y. V. V. Appa Rao.

The Board of Studies (BoS) Meetings for all departments were conducted on 15 October 2025, with eminent academicians from various institutions participating to review and update curriculum in accordance with academic and industry requirements. From 3rd to 8th November 2025, a One-Week (36 Hours) Transferable Skill Training Programme was organized for 43 final-year MCA and MBA girl students, sponsored by the Naandi Foundation, focusing on workplace competencies and professional development. The college observed National Education Day on 11th November 2025, during which students took a pledge commemorating the 75th anniversary of the National Song "Vande Mataram." Principal Dr. Y. V. V. Appa Rao addressed the gathering on the significance of education in nation building. As a part of its extension activities, students visited Prasanthi Old Age Home, Penugonda, on 14th November 2025 and organized free medical camps including eye, dental, and general health check-ups with the support of local medical practitioners.

A mandatory Long-Term Internship Programme for third-year degree students was successfully implemented from 1st December 2025 to 21st March 2026, providing practical industry exposure and enhancing employability skills. The college organized a National Seminar on "Challenges and Solutions in Higher Education" on 11th December 2025, providing a platform for academicians and researchers to deliberate on contemporary issues in higher education. National Consumer Day was observed on 23rd December 2025 by the Department of Economics. Mr. Aloka Raju Penmatsa (USA) delivered an enlightening guest lecture on consumer rights and responsibilities.

As a part of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations, a massive Plantation Drive was conducted on 7th January 2026, during which nearly 1,000 saplings were planted across the campus. The college proudly celebrated its Golden Jubilee from 10th to 12th January 2026, with the participation of Ministers, Members of the Legislative Assembly, alumni, stakeholders, academicians, industrialists, faculty, and students. On the occasion of Republic Day 2026, competitions on Indian Democracy were organized. Dr. K. Ramachandra Raju, Secretary and Correspondent of the College, graced the occasion as the Chief Guest.

The college successfully organized a Mega Job Mela, sponsored by APSSDC, on 5th February 2026. A total of 1,213 candidates participated, and 242 candidates secured employment, marking a significant achievement in placement activities. A Pool Campus Recruitment Drive by Divi's Laboratories, Hyderabad, was organized on 6th February 2026 for Chemistry students. Out of 46 participants, 30 students were selected. A guest lecture on "IT Careers and Microsoft Power Platform" was delivered on 13th February 2026 by Mr. Ephraim Injamuri, CEO, eB2Inc., Los Angeles, USA, benefiting 168 UG and PG students.

The college organized a 10-Day Communication Skills Training Programme, sponsored by APSSDC, from 23rd February to 6th March 2026 for 72 undergraduate students, followed by a 6-Day Aptitude Training Programme from 9th to 16th March 2026 for 68 UG and PG students. An On-Campus Recruitment Drive for teaching positions was organized by Sri Chaitanya Schools, Rajamahendravaram Region, on 4th April 2026, during which 14 M.Sc. students were selected.

To promote awareness of innovation and intellectual assets, the college organized a Workshop on Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) on 13th April 2026. The resource person, Dr. R. S. R. K. Kiran Kumar, Faculty, School of Maritime Management (SCINDIA Campus), Indian Maritime University, Visakhapatnam, delivered an insightful lecture on patents, copyrights, trademarks, and innovation management. The IQAC also organized a Workshop on Drone Technology on 4th May 2026 in collaboration with Flyfusion Solutions (OPC) Private Limited. Ms.D.Sindhu Devi, Director, served as the resource person and introduced students to emerging applications of drone technology across various sectors.

Throughout the academic year, the IQAC continuously monitored and facilitated quality enhancement initiatives in teaching-learning processes, research promotion, extension activities, student support, employability enhancement, environmental sustainability, and institutional best practices. These initiatives significantly contributed to the holistic development of students and strengthened the institution's commitment to academic excellence.

I express my sincere gratitude to the College Management, Principal, Faculty Members, Administrative Staff, Students, Alumni, and all Stakeholders for their unwavering support, cooperation, and dedication in achieving the quality objectives of the IQAC.
