The college adopts some of the above issues and part of curriculum in various semesters. In addition, the college has taken the following steps to address the above issues.

1. Gender: Some programs were conducted for women and girl students such as Rangoli, Food Festival, Quiz, Elocution and Essay Writing Competitions, Hemoglobin Checkup Camps. The committee for women anti arrestment and internal complaints committed organized programs on Women Empowerment, Laws for women on Women's Day. The NSS Unit of our college is very prior to in conducting different extension activities not only college premises but also in adopted villages. Major gender issues are focused and address through activities like Save Girl Child Campaign.
2. Environmental and Sustainability: Our College NSS Units promotes environmental protection through tree plantation, vehicle free day, and distribution of pamphlets on usage of plastic free and sound pollution and sustainable development programs. Every year NSS Units undertake activities in the nearby villages during the Special Camps. In these camps NSS Organizers various environmental related programs including tree plantation, village cleanliness, and plastic free drive. Our college has a Eco Club which conducts various activities to create awareness about nature, bio-diversity, environmental and sustainability. Eco Club celebrates Ozone Day, World Environment Day to create awareness among students.
3. Human Values and Professional Ethics: The College takes efforts integration of ethical and human values through curricular and extracurricular activities. NSS and NCC Units, Social Science Departments conduct various programs which inculcate the human values among the students. Guest lecture are conducted for value base education. National festival like Independence Day, Republic Day serve as a platform to create patriotic and moral values among students. Different social activities have been initiated by the college like health and hygiene awareness programs, medical checkup programs, AIDS awareness programs, voter's day programs, road safety campaign and blood donation camps etc.
